



English translation of RFI's Press Release Update 10 December 2020

From 6 pm rail traffic has been reactivated regularly on the entire Verona - Brennero line. Yesterday evening, the Bolzano-Brenner section was reactivated.

Traffic had been **suspended** on **Saturday 5th December** due to severe **bad weather** which caused a **landslide** near the Virgolo tunnel, south of Bolzano, and a breakdown in the power supply systems of the electricity operator between Bolzano and the Brenner Pass.

Replacement buses have been activated to ensure service during the period of suspension of rail traffic.

In order to support the coordination between the Infrastructure Managers involved, during the interruption, the Scandinavian-Mediterranean Freight Corridor started the international collaboration table as provided for by the ICM - International Contingency Management procedure.
